Code-breaker, philosopher and mathematician, Charles Babbage was one of the pioneers of computing. At 42, he designed the complex Analytical Engine, the revolutionary device which performed arithmetical calculations using punched cards. This laid the groundwork for computers as we now know them and helped secure him fame as the father of the modern computer.
